Access to HE Diploma (Business and Management)

If you don't have the grades you need to apply for a business degree course at university, this programme is for you.

Access to HE course

Student Finance England will “write off” any outstanding Advanced Learner Loan balances you owe for an Access to HE course once you complete a higher education course. This means you don’t have to repay it. The higher education course must be eligible for Student Finance.

No upfront costs

The government has introduced Advanced Learner Loans to help learners aged 19 and over in further education pay the college or training organisation fee. Getting a loan doesn’t depend on your household income and there’s no credit check. You won’t have to pay anything back until you’re earning over £21,000 a year. Once you earn over this amount, you pay back 9% of the earnings you receive above this figure.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the loan, you must be 19 or older on the first day of your course (there’s no upper age limit), be living in the UK on the first day of your course, and have lived in the UK, the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man for 3 years immediately before this.
